In Nicaragua, he served as a professor of pastoral counseling and Christian Education at the Ecumenical Center for Theological and Social Studies in Managua, Matagalpa, and Juigalpa for 6 years. He started a trauma recovery ministry, "Sanacion en Nombre de Jesucristo," for victim-survivors of a mudslide caused by Hurricane Mitch, October 30, 1998, which killed 3,054 persons. He served as parish associate 7 years with the Moravian Church of Managua, (tri-lingual, Spanish, Miskito, English) leading in worship, music, and preaching, and counseling children and families. He was one of the founding pastor of The Holy Way Presbyterian Church in Tucson.
