Loss and Legacy in Safford



It was with a measure of sadness that Presbytery de Cristo voted to dissolve the Shepherd of the Valley (SOTV) congregation, pending the successful transfer of the property to the True Hope Fellowship, a non-denominational congregation that will continue Christian witness with a Protestant voice in the Safford community. The original plan proposed by the SOTV Administrative Commission (AC) was to divide the property into two parcels, cleaving the developed 1.5 acres from the undeveloped 3 acres and requesting of True Hope a \$50,000 contribution to our mission partners.
